

Hospital Road trenching and temporary lane closure 12 February 2019 – 20 February 2019

Temporary lane closures along Hospital Road are required to safely undertake trenching work and the installation of a permanent water connection to the new Prince of Wales Hospital Acute Services Building.

Out of hours work will occur on Friday 15 February from 7:00pm – 5:00am. Out of hours work is required to minimise disruptions to Randwick Hospitals Campus and vehicle movements on Hospital Road.

All other work is scheduled to occur during approved site hours Monday to Friday between 6:00am and 6:00pm, and Saturdays between 8:00am and 5:00pm. Work may be rescheduled due to inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances.

Work will include service investigations along Hospital Road, single lane closures to allow trenching along the southbound and northbound lanes of Hospital Road, water testing and services connection of the water main, and road restoration.

What can I expect to see?

Trenching work requires saw-cutting of the Hospital Road surface and the use of small excavators and saw-cutters to dig the trench.

Road plates will be installed over the trench and both lanes will be re-opened at the end of each day. Backfilling and restoration of Hospital Road will occur at the completion of work.

How will access be managed?

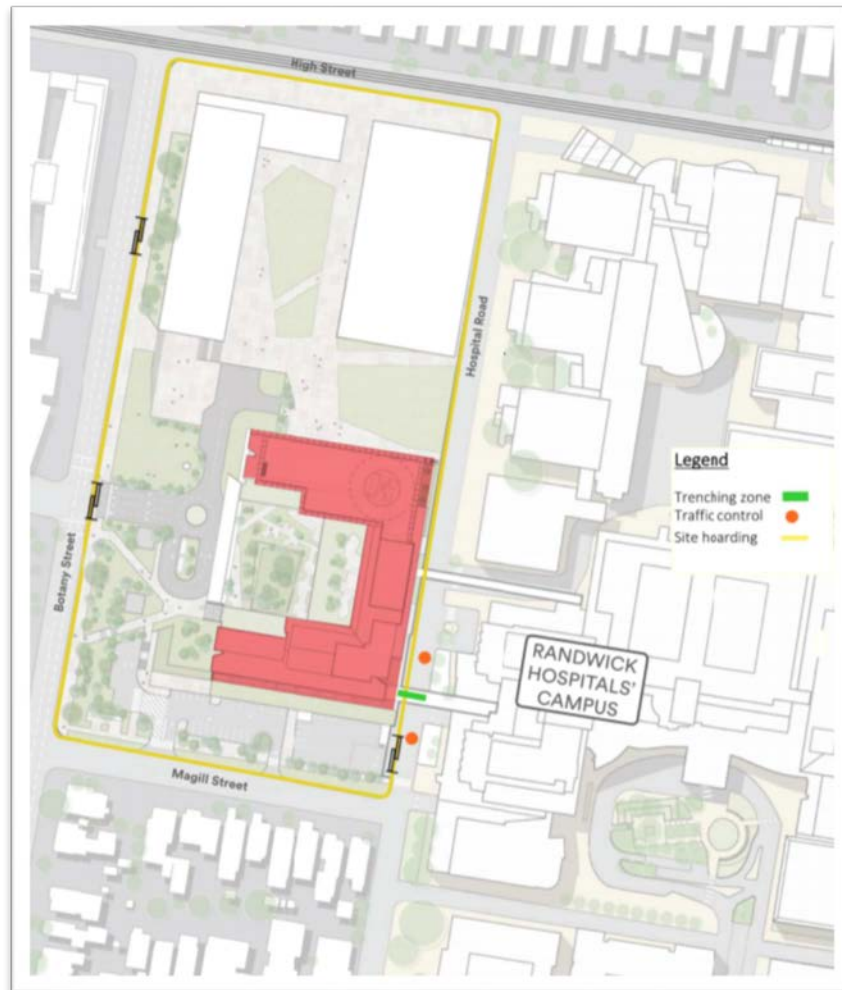
Maintaining hospital and emergency access during this time is our paramount priority. One lane will remain operational at all times with the support of traffic control. Traffic controllers will promptly respond to and direct any vehicle requiring emergency access. The hospital car park and loading dock will remain operational and accessible at all times. Road users and pedestrians will be diverted with the support of traffic controllers.

How will noise, dust and vibration be managed?

Mitigation measures will be implemented to manage noise, dust and vibration during this time. We thank you for your patience as we undertake this important work.
