

Temporary changes to Botany Street pedestrian access

Saturday 23 March 2019

A temporary pedestrian detour will be in place from 8am to 5pm Saturday 23 March 2019 on Botany Street near High Street.

Traffic controllers will direct pedestrians to safely cross Botany Street at a temporary crossing. Ramps and signage will be in place to support pedestrian movements.

This pedestrian detour will allow sheet piling activity to occur at the intersection of Botany Street and High Street. A safety exclusion zone will be established around the work area.

Approval has been granted for this activity to occur on a Saturday when pedestrian and traffic volumes are lower. You may experience some noise and vibration during this work.

We thank you for your patience as we undertake this important work.

Work may be rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances or inclement weather.

What can I expect to see?

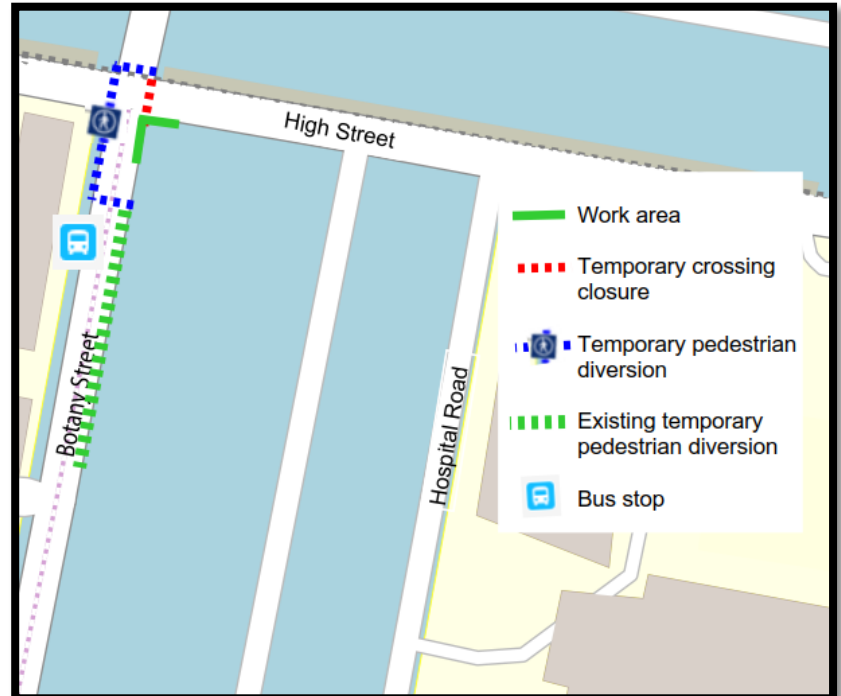
Sheet piling activity will be carried out at the intersection of Botany Street and High Street. This method of piling is used to create an in-ground retention wall and provide excavation support.

Steel sheets with interlocking edges are driven into the ground using a large excavator. Work will be carried out inside the exclusion zone and behind temporary fencing.

This work will occur during standard site hours from 8am to 5pm Saturday 23 March 2019.
