



Planned Night Works

Night works and traffic changes - High Street between Hospital Road and **Botany Street - From 6 April 2020**

Works to re-instate the southern footpath of High Street, between Hospital Road and Botany Street are underway.

For traffic and safety reasons, specific upcoming activities are required to occur during the evening when the westbound traffic lane of High Street can be closed - work will occur during evening shifts from 8pm to 6am.

Work on the footpath restoration including landscaping of the road verge and construction of two new stormwater pits is scheduled to occur from early April into May 2020. Noise mitigations will be in place throughout the works and higher noise activities will be limited to two consecutive nights in a row.

The following traffic changes and work activities will be in place during the work.

Managing traffic and access during the work

- The westbound traffic lane on High Street will temporarily close during each evening shift between Hospital Road and Botany Street with traffic detours in place. The road will reopen each day after the evening working shift.
- A safety exclusion zone, lighting towers, traffic controllers and signage will be in place to support the safe movement of vehicles and pedestrians and to safely undertake the work.
- Please follow the directions of traffic controllers who are there to assist road users and pedestrians.
- Access to the hospitals and private property will be maintained throughout the works.

Managing noise and lighting during the work


- Residents may expect to see lighting towers and hear some noise during the work.
- Most of the work activities involved are lower noise activities such as establishment of safe working zones and traffic signage, general construction and landscaping activities. Limited higher noise work is expected and will include activities such as saw-cutting and rock-breaking. Where possible, noisy works will be completed early in the shift.
- Lighting towers will be angled downwards to reduce light spill on nearby residential properties.
