

Temporary traffic changes and water and sewer disconnections to properties 2-14 Magill Street

From 5 November 2018 – 10 November 2018

From Monday, 5 November 2018, water and sewer disconnections will be carried out for vacated properties on Magill Street (properties 2-14 Magill Street).

Work will occur outside the construction hoarding on the road pavement. The water supply to private or occupied properties will not be affected during this work.

We thank you for your patience as we undertake this important work.

Temporary traffic management changes

To safely undertake the disconnections, a single lane closure of the northern lane of Magill Street is required from 5 November for approximately 6 days. Work will occur with the support of traffic control between 6am to 5pm Monday to Friday and between 8am to 5pm Saturday. Saw-cutting and rock-breaking will not occur prior to 7am weekdays to minimise noise impacts on nearby residents.

Work may be rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances or inclement weather.

What can I expect to see?

Disconnection work requires saw cutting of the road surface, manual and machine digging to reach water and sewer connections, backfilling and road restoration. Small excavators, saw cutters, some truck and personnel will be used to carry out this work.

All road surfaces will be tidied to remove any debris caused by this work.

How will access be managed?

Access for road users, pedestrians and residents will be maintained at all times under the support of traffic control. Excavations will be backfilled and both lanes re-opened at the end of each shift.
