Construction site access gate installation – Hospital Road Monday 15 April 2019 – Thursday 18 April 2019

Work to establish the Randwick Campus Redevelopment project site is underway.

A temporary, single lane closure on Hospital Road is required to safely establish the construction site access gate located on Hospital Road near the campus carpark exits. One lane on Hospital Road will remain operational at all times with the support of traffic control.

We thank you for your patience as we undertake this important work.

Work activities

- Establish work zone at the construction site gate location with traffic controllers assisting traffic flow
- Remove tree stumps in the vicinity of the gate location using a vacuum excavation truck
- Saw-cutting of the road surface, construction of the concrete driveway and gate footings, and installation of construction site access gate
- Road restoration and tidying up of the area.

Work hours

All work is scheduled to occur during approved site hours Monday to Friday 6:00am to 6:00pm, and Saturday 8:00am to 5:00pm.

Work may be rescheduled due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.

What can I expect to see?

This work requires saw-cutting of Hospital Road and trenching using small excavators and saw-cutters. Excavation of tree stumps in the location requires vacuum excavation to avoid any damage to nearby underground utilities. Backfilling and restoration of Hospital Road will occur at the completion of work.

How will access be managed?

Hospital and emergency access will be maintained throughout the work. Traffic controllers will promptly respond to and direct any vehicle requiring emergency access.

The hospital car park and loading dock will remain operational and accessible at all times.

will open in 2022.


