

## Temporary single lane closures – Hospital Road and Delivery Drive Randwick Hospitals Campus Electricity Upgrade – 25 November 2019 to 31 March 2020

Construction work for the Randwick Campus Redevelopment and new Prince of Wales Hospital Acute Services Building is well underway. As part of the upcoming construction program, an important upgrade to the Randwick Hospitals Campus electricity supply requires temporary, single lane closures along Hospital Road and Delivery Drive. Hospital and emergency access will be maintained at all times and traffic controllers and signage will be in place during the works.

For your safety, please pay attention and follow the direction of traffic controllers. We thank you for your patience as we undertake this important work.

### Work activities

- Temporary single lane closures and trenching on Hospital Road and Delivery Drive
- Establishment of safety exclusion zones using safety barriers and temporary fencing
- Construction of two large in-ground pits on Hospital Road (refer map overside)
- Installation of underground electrical cables
- Removal of some vegetation, kerb modifications and road restoration.

Construction activity is scheduled to occur during approved site construction hours Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm, and Saturday 8am to 5pm.

Some activities may occur outside standard hours for traffic and safety reasons, which will be notified in advance.

In the event of inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances this work may need to be rescheduled.

### What can I expect to see?

Safety exclusion zones will be established around work areas using barriers and temporary fencing to maintain the safety of construction workers, road users and pedestrians.

Pit construction and trenching requires saw-cutting of Hospital Road, digging using excavators, truck movements and general construction activities. Backfilling and restoration of Hospital Road will occur at the completion of work.

Where possible this work will be undertaken during the day to minimise noise and disruption to nearby services and residents.

### Changes to vehicle and pedestrian access

**Hospital and emergency access will be maintained at all times.**

Traffic controllers will promptly respond to and direct any vehicle requiring emergency access.

**Single lane closures on Hospital Road and Delivery Drive will be in place during this work.**

Two-way access will be maintained under stop-go traffic arrangements. Traffic controllers will support the safe and coordinated movement of pedestrians and vehicles around the work zones during work hours. Signage and temporary traffic lights will be in place to support vehicle movements out of work hours.

Hospital loading docks will remain accessible at all times under contra-flow traffic arrangements.

**Motorbike parking zone** – The motorbike parking zone on Hospital Road near the work area will be relocated south on Hospital Road. Directional signage will be installed. Some additional changes to car parking arrangements in the area of the works will be directly communicated to any affected work areas.

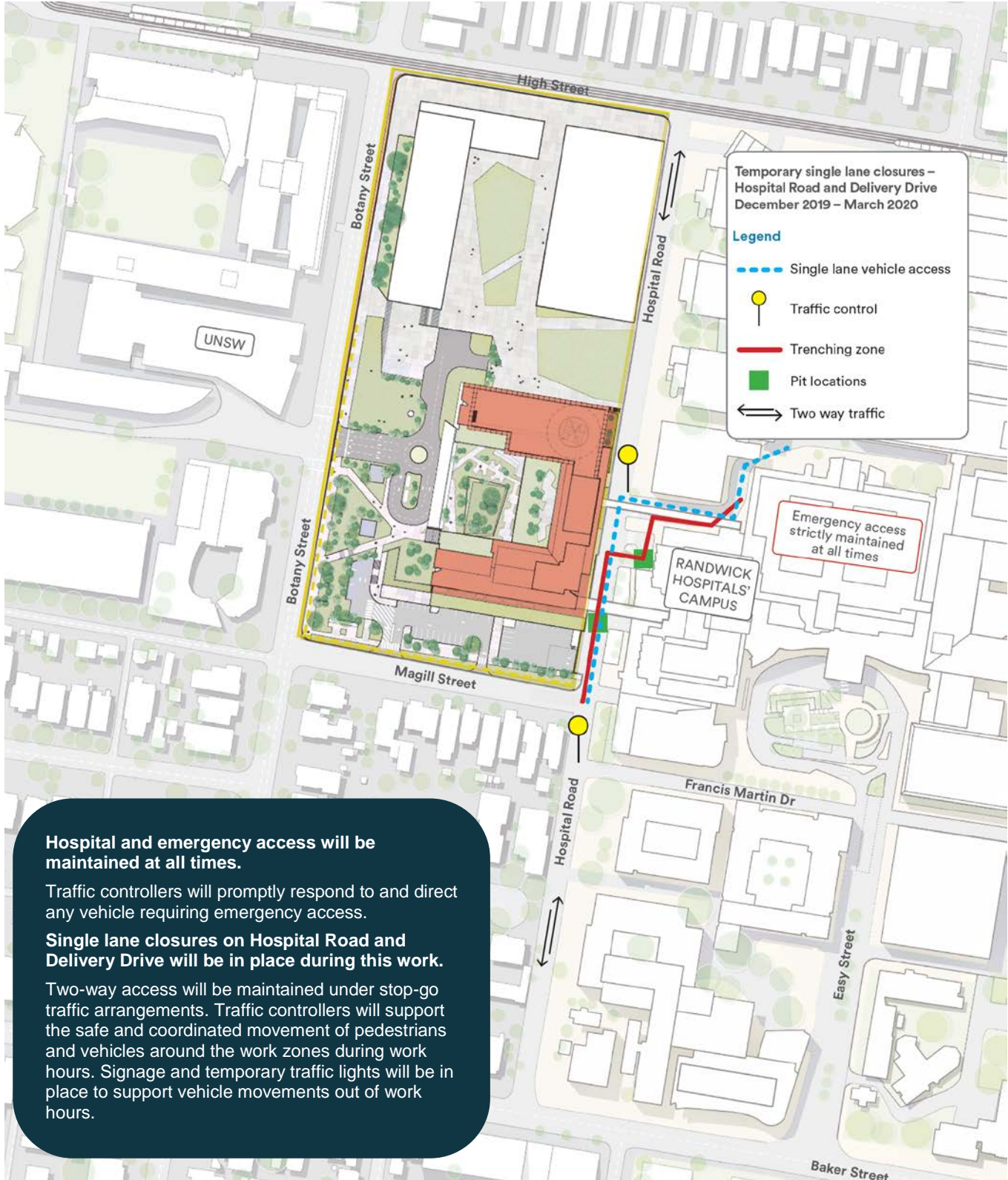
