



High Street temporary single lane closure – Rescheduled work date

We previously provided information about work underway to connect a new sewer as part of the Randwick Campus Redevelopment. This work has now been rescheduled and will occur on Friday 27 September 2019.

For traffic and safety reasons this work will occur in the evening (from 8pm to 5am). Services to private property will not be affected during this work. We thank you for your patience as we undertake this important work.

Work may be rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances or inclement weather.

What can I expect to see?

A suction pump will be used to carry out this work. A safety exclusion zone will be in place on High Street to safely undertake this work and traffic control will be on site to assist pedestrians and vehicles move safely past the work area.

How will access be managed?

- A single lane closure of the westbound lane of High Street, between Hospital Road and Botany Street will be in place
- · Access to the hospitals and private property will be maintained at all times
- One lane of traffic will be maintained along High Street at all times
- Pedestrians will be diverted to the footpath on the northern side of High Street
- Traffic controllers and signage will support the safe movement of vehicles and pedestrians.
