Hospital Road trenching and temporary lane closure

Monday 29 April 2019 – Tuesday 7 May 2019

Work to establish the Randwick Campus Redevelopment project site is underway.

Temporary, single lane closures, along Hospital Road are required to safely undertake trenching work and installation of a temporary electricity kiosk. The kiosk will supply power for the Randwick Campus Redevelopment construction site. One lane will remain operational at all times with the support of traffic control.

We thank you for your patience as we undertake this important work.

Work activities

- Temporary closure and trenching along the northbound lane of Hospital Road
- Temporary closure of the southbound lane of Hospital Road and trenching across Hospital Road
- Installation of conduits and connection temporary builder's supply kiosk
- Road restoration and tidying

Work hours

All work is scheduled to occur during approved site hours Monday to Friday 6:00am to 6:00pm, and Saturday 8:00am to 5:00pm.

Work may be rescheduled due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.

What can I expect to see?

Trenching work requires saw-cutting of Hospital Road and trenching using small excavators and saw-cutters. Backfilling and restoration of Hospital Road will occur at the completion of work.

Road plates will be installed over the trench and both lanes will be re-opened at the end of each day.

How will access be managed?

Maintaining hospital and emergency access during this time is our paramount priority. Traffic controllers will promptly respond to and direct any vehicle requiring emergency access.

The hospital car park and loading dock will remain operational and accessible at all times.

Road users and pedestrians will be diverted with the support of traffic controllers.

About the Randwick Campus Redevelopment


The NSW Government is investing \$720 million to strengthen the Randwick health and education precinct as a world-leading centre for health and wellbeing, research, education and teaching.
