

# **Community Notice - September 2019**

Enabling work and construction activity for the Randwick Campus Redevelopment will continue throughout September.

The health and safety of patients, families, visitors, staff and the community is our top priority.

The Randwick Campus Redevelopment complies with strict environmental and planning controls and measures are in place to monitor and manage noise, dust and vibration.

We are working closely with Transport for NSW, CBD and South East Light Rail, UNSW and Randwick City Council to coordinate construction in the Randwick Precinct and minimise the impact on the area.

Activities may be rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances or inclement weather.

## **Construction activities continuing during September 2019**

- Piling and bulk excavation
- Trenching and rock excavation
- Installation of sewer and stormwater infrastructure
- Temporary Botany Street pedestrian diversions
- Out of hours construction deliveries

- Undergrounding of overhead power and telecommunications services on Botany Street
- Botany Street tree removal
- Hoarding modifications and pedestrian diversions
- Work activities on or near the site boundary.

# New and upcoming activities

- Temporary changes to parking on the northern kerb of Magill Street are required to support the relocation of important underground services. Approximately 5 parking spaces may be occupied for up to 2 weeks during the month. No service outages are planned during this work.
- The westbound lane of High Street, between Hospital Road and Botany Street, will be temporarily closed for up to four evenings during the month (between 8:00pm and 5:00am for traffic and safety reasons) to enable work on important underground infrastructure in the area. No service outages are planned during this work.

#### **Construction site hours**

- Monday to Friday, 7:00am to 6:00pm
- Saturday, 8:00am to 5:00pm

Truck movements are being minimised during peak traffic times to reduce impacts on local roads and the community.
