Hospital Road cable pulling and electricity upgrades: Extended working hours and night works from 18 April 2020

Work to upgrade the Ausgrid High Voltage network supply to the Randwick Hospital Campus has been underway in High Street, Hospital Road and Delivery Drive.

To complete the work, power cables will be pulled through the recently installed conduits and pits, and electrical work will power up the new cables.

These activities will occur during non-standard working hours and are scheduled for:

- Saturday 18 and Sunday 19 April 2020*, 7am-7pm
- Up to ten week-night shifts 8pm-8am between 20 April and 14 May 2020.*

*The scheduling of the work may be impacted by inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances.

Power and access to the hospitals and private properties will be maintained throughout the works.

Where possible, noisier works for this activity will be scheduled during standard work hours with lower impact activities such as cable pulling and electrical work continuing later in the shift.

Compaction and road reinstatement is also required once the cables are installed.

Lighting towers will be used to provide safe working conditions and will be positioned to minimise light spill on surrounding buildings.
