Night time work, Hospital Road Monday 25 November 2019

As part of an important electricity upgrade for the Randwick Hospitals Campus, tree removal and kerb modifications will be carried out near the Royal Hospital for Women on Hospital Road during the evening of Monday 25 November.

For safety and traffic reasons, and to maintain hospital functions during the day, this work will occur outside of standard hours from 6pm to 6am under approval by Ausgrid.

Where possible, noisier work will be carried out prior to 10pm. You may experience some noise or vibration during the works.

Tree removal will be undertaken by a skilled arborist using chainsaws, tree trimming and mulching equipment. Three trees will be removed to enable services work along Hospital Road. Prior to commencement of work each tree will be inspected for wildlife. If any wildlife is found to be present it will be relocated.

Kerb modifications will be carried out using a small excavator and jack hammer. Safety exclusions zones will be in place. Pedestrians will be diverted around safety exclusion zones.

Work may be rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances or inclement weather.
