## Delivering a connected, integrated and compassionate centre of excellence

The Randwick Health and Education Precinct is one of the most comprehensive in Australia. Home to children's, women's and adult hospitals, a major private hospital, globally recognised medical research institutes and one of the world's top 100 universities, the Precinct's diverse and integrated approach to research and education is improving patient health care and outcomes.

### The strength of the Precinct

The Randwick Campus Redevelopment will further strengthen the Precinct through the delivery of over \$1.5 billion in state-of-the-art health, education and research infrastructure.

Through partnerships with the Federal Government, UNSW Sydney, the Sydney Children's Hospital Network and the Children's Cancer Institute, the NSW Government is delivering the following world-class facilities:

- Prince of Wales Hospital Acute Services Building
- Sydney Children's Hospital Stage 1 redevelopment, including Australia's first Children's Comprehensive Cancer Centre
- UNSW Sydney's Health Translation Hub.



### Future proofing the Randwick Hospitals Campus

The lowering of Hospital Road and closure to through traffic will future-proof construction of the Sydney Children's Hospital Stage 1 and the Health Translation Hub to the north of the Redevelopment site, and facilitates loading dock access to both new buildings.

This work will also deliver ambulance access for the new Sydney Children's Hospital facility.

The Randwick Campus Redevelopment will significantly revitalise the campus and create a responsive and pedestrian-friendly urban environment. The project's landscape strategy together with the design of public open spaces will transform the Precinct into a welcoming and healing destination that meets the needs of the community now and into the future.

### Transforming Hospital Road

The Randwick Campus Redevelopment will bring Hospital Road into the centre of the expanded hospitals campus. With this comes the opportunity to reimagine this part of the campus within the context of the Precinct's vision to create healthy, green and connected spaces.

As the project progresses, the purpose and function of Hospital Road will change, transitioning the road into a largely back-of-house service lane that will continue to support campus logistics and emergency access as well as access to the campus carpark from the south via Barker and Magill Streets.

A pedestrian deck will be built over the northern section of Hospital Road as part of the Sydney Children's Hospital Stage 1 project. This will provide safe and integrated pedestrian connectivity between new and existing health services.

### Traffic conditions are changing

To deliver this transformation as well as current and future stages of the project, changes to Hospital Road are required. This includes the lowering of a section of Hospital Road and closing the road to through traffic to / from High Street, just north of Delivery Drive.

These changes will also support improvements to be made to the loading dock, allowing the current steep ramp down into the deck to be replaced by a level route.

To mitigate traffic impacts resulting from the changes to Hospital Road, Magill Street will be reopened between 7am and 10pm.

Boom gates will restrict through access to Magill Street between 10pm and 7am to mitigate the potential impact of traffic noise on local residents.

This change will be supported by signposting.
