

Stormwater upgrade on Hospital Road

Stormwater infrastructure upgrades will commence shortly on Hospital Road and Magill Street. The upgrades will increase the capacity of the local stormwater system for the neighbourhood and support the stormwater requirements of the Randwick Campus Redevelopment.

The stormwater upgrade works include:

- site preparatory works and vegetation management
- saw cutting of the existing road surface
- excavation works
- installation of new stormwater pipes
- backfilling of the trench
- temporary reinstatement of the road surface.

Once completed, the road surface will be permanently reinstated.

Scheduling works


In preparation for the stormwater upgrades, service investigations and relocations are required and will commence shortly.

The stormwater upgrade works are anticipated to occur through late 2021.

Due to current Covid-19 restrictions, dates are subject to change due to workforce availability.

Managing construction activity

The Randwick Campus Redevelopment complies with strict environmental and planning controls. During construction we are committed to minimising disturbance to our neighbours and local community.

To maintain traffic and access and ensure operational continuity of the Randwick Hospitals Campus:

- works will be completed in sections along Hospital Road before crossing into Magill Street
- Hospital Road will be reduced to a single lane for vehicular use for the duration of the works
- traffic management will be in place to ensure the safe movement of vehicles
- installation of infrastructure across Hospital Road will be scheduled on weekends when hospital logistics demands are lower.

Managing noise, dust and vibration

Measures to manage noise, vibration and dust will be implemented for the duration of works. These include:

- selection and use of equipment to manage construction impacts, such as using saws in place of jackhammers where possible
- respite periods for high noise activities
- staging the work to allow the compound to move as each section is completed
- wetting down of the work area to ensure appropriate dust management
- turning off equipment when not in use
- noise and vibration monitoring in place.
