

Throughout 2021, construction will continue for the Prince of Wales Hospital Integrated Acute Services Building (IASB); the first stage of the Randwick Campus Redevelopment and the catalyst project for expanding world-class health, research and education facilities at the Randwick precinct.

The Randwick Campus Redevelopment would like to take this opportunity to thank you, the local community, for your ongoing patience while we work to deliver this important project for the NSW Community.

During the holiday season, the site will close from Thursday, 24 December 2020 and re-open Monday, 4 January 2021. During this time there will be no work undertaken on site. Additional security patrols will be in place, 24/7 to maintain site security and safety.

Key construction activities continuing during January 2021 include:

- IASB concrete pouring, structural works and façade installation
- Stage 3 Hospital Road works including piling and road pavement construction along Hospital Road (north)
- Minor works will continue along Hospital Road (south) to reinstate road pavements and footpaths
- Access to Delivery Drive via Hospital Road (south) from Barker Street
- Service utility investigations, relocations and upgrades
- Works internal to the Hospital Campus car park

The construction of a Bulk oxygen storage facility will also commence on Francis Martin Drive. Single lane closures and traffic control will be in place.

Modifications to an existing median strip, at the intersection of Barker Street and Hospital Road, will likely occur out of hours and will be notified accordingly.

Construction hours

The majority of activities are scheduled during approved construction hours - Monday to Friday 6am - 10pm and Saturday 7am - 5pm. To support works along Hospital Road, deliveries of large equipment will occur out of hours. It is a requirement of Transport for NSW that equipment movements of this size occur out of hours.

Other work may be planned outside of the approved construction hours to ensure the safety of workers, pedestrians and motorists, and to minimise impacts to local traffic and hospital access. Activities are dependent on weather and site conditions and subject to change. Out of hours work will be notified in advance accordingly.

Minimising construction impacts

We are committed to minimising the impact of our works where we can. All construction activities are carried out with the health and safety of the local community as our top priority. We endeavour to keep noise, dust and vibration to a minimum.
