

**Notification of works –
High Street and Hospital Road,
30 March to 2 April inclusive**

Intermittent works on High Street and Hospital Road will be undertaken throughout 2023 to support construction of the new Sydney Children's Hospital Stage 1 and Minderoo Children's Comprehensive Cancer Centre.

Following the completion of previously communicated works to instal a new kiosk substation, further works are now required to enable its connection to the power network.

These works are scheduled for the following dates, weather permitting:

Thursday 30 March, 7am to 6pm

Friday 31 March, 7am to 6pm

Saturday 1 April, 7am to 6pm

Sunday 2 April, 8am to 4pm.

Activities will include removal of temporary pit covers, connection of low and high voltage cables, backfilling and temporary footpath restoration, requiring associated equipment and machinery. Some noise impacts may be experienced.

To support these works, the High Street footpath adjacent to the construction site will be closed between Hospital Road and Botany Street from Friday to Sunday inclusive, with pedestrian diversions in place.

There are no planned power outages to surrounding residents or the hospital as part of these works.

Access to the hospital and Children's Emergency will be maintained at all times through traffic control.

This work is carried out under an Ausgrid Authority approval.
