



Notification of weekend works and road closure – tower crane installation, Saturday 19 and Sunday 20 August 2023

To support ongoing construction of the new UNSW Health Translation Hub, weekend site activities will be undertaken in August by UNSW's construction partner, Hansen Yunken, to install the first of three tower cranes.

Approved installation activities will occur between the hours of 1.30am and 8.30pm on Saturday 19 August, potentially extending to Sunday 20 August between the hours of 6.30am and 5pm.

To enable this activity, a section of Botany Street will be temporarily closed from 1.30am Saturday until completion of related activities. Traffic controllers and signage will support vehicle detours.

During the road closure, access to Botany Street between High Street and Barker Street will be restricted to residents, emergency vehicles and hospital patients only, while maintaining access to residential properties, Prince of Wales Hospital Acute Services Building and the Adult Emergency Department.

Pedestrian access along Botany Street adjacent to the worksite will be restricted to the western footpath throughout the works.
