Notification of night works protective gantry hoarding installation, 12 to 15 October

To support ongoing construction activities of the new Sydney Children's Hospital Stage 1 and Minderoo Children's Comprehensive Cancer Centre, night works to finalise the installation of a protective overhead gantry hoarding will be undertaken at the corner of Hospital Road and High Street.

The gantry hoarding is required to enable adjacent construction activities to progress safely over the vehicle egress route from the Sydney Children's Hospital.

Approved out of hours installation activities will occur between 6pm and 6am across four evenings from Thursday 12 to Sunday 15 October inclusive, weather permitting.

Construction activity will include the use of machinery and equipment, including the tower crane, fork and scissor lifts to install the supporting structure, along with associated lighting.

Intermittent construction noise is likely as a result of these installation works. It is intended that the noisiest work components will be carried out in the early evening (where possible).

To enable the works, visitor parking restrictions will be in place at the Sydney Children's Hospital Main Entrance. Signage and traffic control will support parking restrictions and associated vehicle detours.

There will be no impact to the Children's Emergency Department access.
