

Construction Update

Construction work is ongoing on the Randwick Campus Redevelopment site, which includes the Sydney Children's Hospital Stage 1 and Minderoo Children's Comprehensive Cancer Centre (SCH1/MCCCC) building, UNSW's Health Translation Hub (HTH), along with continued works within the Prince of Wales Hospital Acute Services Building (ASB) and associated UNSW Eastern Extension.

Upcoming activities

Sydney Children's Hospital Stage 1 and Minderoo Children's Comprehensive Cancer Centre

Construction activities for the structural elements continue to progress, including formwork, steel fixing and concrete pouring.

Early fit-out activities are now underway within the lower levels of the new building, including the future loading dock and Emergency Department. Activities include wall installation and service fit-out works.

Weekend site activity is planned during November to raise the height of the tower cranes, along with out of hours activities to deliver construction materials and equipment. Detailed information will be provided to affected stakeholders ahead of works commencing.

Prince of Wales Hospital Acute Services Building

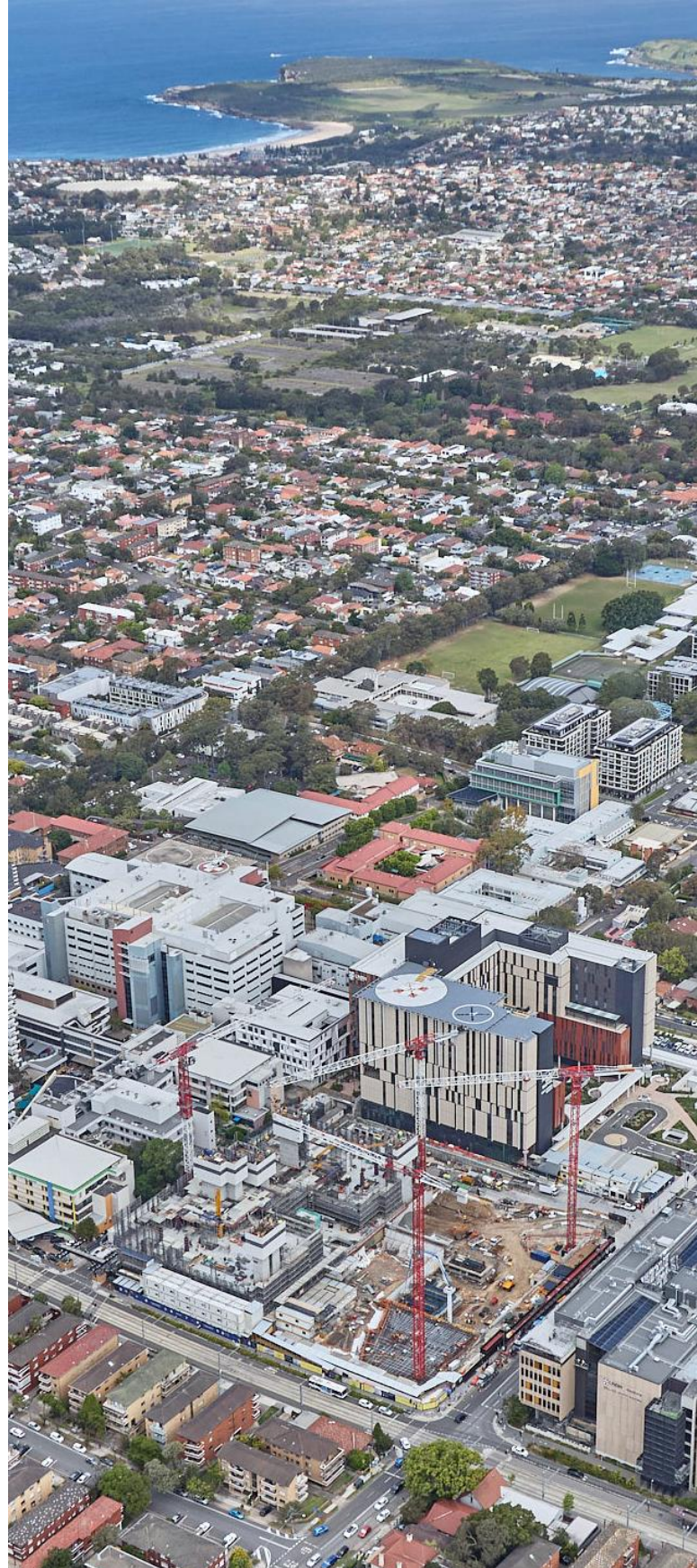
Internal fit-out of additional inpatient units on Level 6 of the new ASB are nearing completion, with final building commissioning and validation activities occurring in November.

Hospital commissioning activities within the space will commence in coming months and include the installation of furniture, equipment and stock; training and orientation for clinical and non-clinical staff; and clinical cleans.

Further internal fit-out works will be undertaken within the building throughout 2024 to accommodate additional operating theatres on Level 1.

UNSW Eastern Extension

Construction activities to fit-out the 10 floors of the UNSW Eastern Extension continue, including partitioning and service installations, in readiness for the spaces to become operational in early 2024.

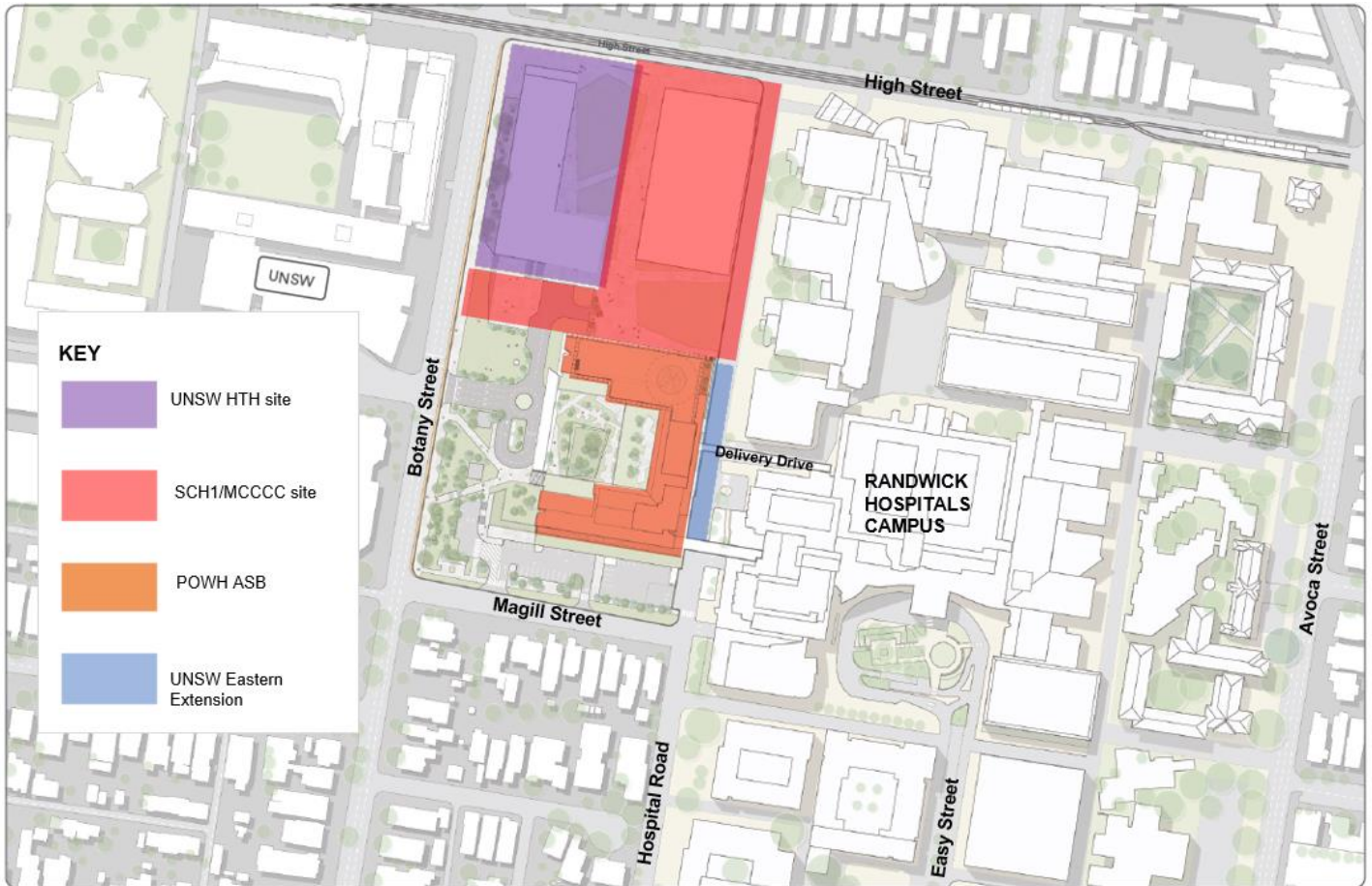


UNSW Health Translation Hub

Foundation works for the future UNSW Health Translation Hub continue to progress, including excavation and inground service installation.

Construction activities for core structural elements will continue throughout November, including framing for staged concrete pours of the suspended slabs.
