Botany Street signalised intersection works

The Randwick Campus Redevelopment team continues work on the delivery of a new four-way signalised intersection on Botany Street, Randwick, in preparation for the opening of the new Prince of Wales Hospital Acute Services building.

The remaining intersection works during January and February will include:

- installation of traffic control signals
- road line marking
- footpath paving reinstatement.

Approved standard construction working hours are 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday, and 8am to 5pm, Saturday.

For traffic and safety reasons, night works may be required to safely undertake the works.

Out of hours works are approved to occur up to four nights per week from 6pm to 6am (no work on Saturday nights).

Any two consecutive nights of work will be followed by a respite night.

Where possible, disruptive activities will be scheduled as early in the evening as possible.
