

Hospital Road Construction



Night works – High Street and Hospital Road north underground power upgrade

Construction activities are continuing on the northern section of Hospital Road as part of the new Sydney Children's Hospital Stage 1 and Minderoo Children's Comprehensive Cancer Centre.

Night works to install power cables along High Street and Hospital Road, in the vicinity of the Sydney Children's Hospital High Street drop-off are planned to commence from **Sunday 17 July**.

Works are scheduled during the following times:

- Monday - Thursday 7:30PM – 5:00AM
- Sunday 7:30PM – 5:00AM

The works will occur for a duration of approximately two weeks, weather dependent.

Access to the Sydney Children's Hospital and Children's Emergency will be maintained at all times throughout the work.

What can you expect during these works?

There may be some intermittent noise or vibration throughout the approved hours caused by:

- excavation and concreting works
- general equipment including trucks and excavators
- pulling of cables and finishing works

Noise generating work will be monitored and prioritised for the start of each shift.
