

Notification of night works – High Street and Hospital Road, Monday 13 and Tuesday 14 March

Intermittent night works on High Street and Hospital Road will be undertaken throughout 2023 to support construction of the new Sydney Children’s Hospital Stage 1 and Minderoo Children’s Comprehensive Cancer Centre.

Upcoming works are planned for the installation of a new kiosk substation and associated cabling over two nights – Monday 13 and Tuesday 14 March. Works will be scheduled between 8pm and 5am each night.

Activities will include excavation and installation of infrastructure, requiring associated equipment and machinery.

There are no planned power outages to surrounding residents or the hospital as part of these works.

During the works, High Street will be closed to vehicles travelling west between Hospital Road and Botany Street with detours in place.

Access to the hospital and Children’s Emergency will be maintained at all times through traffic control.

This work is carried out under an Ausgrid Authority approval and undertaken at night to manage traffic and pedestrian access and ensure hospital operational continuity.
