Botany Street signalised intersection activation

Works to deliver a new four-way signalised intersection on Botany Street, Randwick, are now complete.

The signalised intersection will support safe pedestrian, cyclist and vehicle access to both the Randwick Hospitals Campus and the UNSW Kensington Campus.

The traffic lights will be activated from 11pm on Sunday 19 February, with initial three-way signal phasing to support improved access to UNSW Kensington Campus.

Access to the new Acute Services Building driveway will remain closed until the building becomes operational. Permanent four-way phasing of the traffic lights will commence at this time.

Transport for NSW will manage signal phasing and timing to provide suitable campus and surrounding area access.
