## Construction is underway on the \$658 million Sydney Children's Hospital Stage 1 and Minderoo Children's Comprehensive Cancer Centre project

Building a new hospital is a complex process and involves several phases of construction activity, including enabling works, early works and main works.

Supported by two large tower cranes, main works construction is now underway for the 12-storey Sydney Children's Hospital Stage 1 and Minderoo Children's Comprehensive Cancer Centre (SCH1/MCCCC) building, with construction completion expected in 2025.

Throughout 2023, staff, patients and community will see an increase in activity occurring on the SCH1/MCCCC construction site next to the existing Sydney Children's Hospital, Randwick.

Safety is our priority, and our project team plans collaboratively to ensure the hospital campus can keep operating throughout activity, with strict measures in place to manage construction impacts.

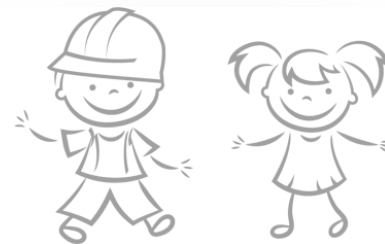
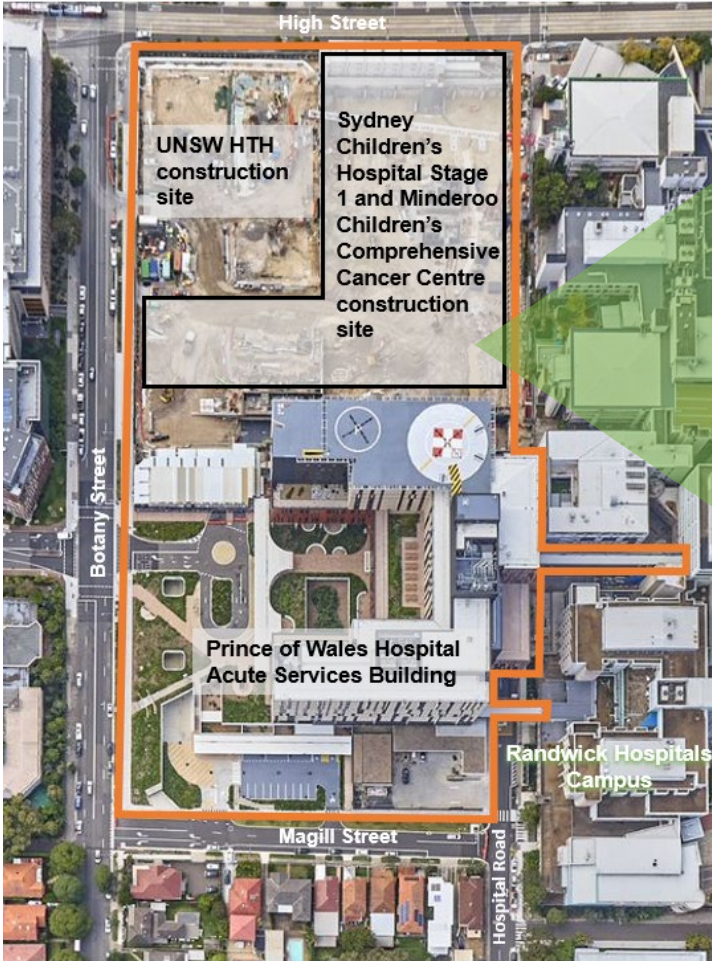

### Managing construction activities

All construction activities are carried out with the health and safety of the local community and site workers as our top priority. We endeavour to keep noise, dust and vibration to a minimum.

Where possible, activities are scheduled during approved site hours of **Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm and Saturday, 8am to 5pm.**

Work may be rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances such as workforce availability.

Any out of hours work will continue to be communicated directly to affected stakeholders in advance.
