

Magill Street boom gate installation – from Wednesday 8 February 2023

As communicated in late 2022, as part of the Randwick Campus Redevelopment a boom gate will be installed at the intersection of Magill Street and Hospital Road to support improved amenity for residents and safe and efficient access to the new Emergency Department (ED).

Construction activity to install the boom gate will commence from **Wednesday 8 February** and be undertaken on weekdays between 7am and 5pm for approximately two weeks.

Activities will include:

- construction vehicle movements
- minor excavation works
- installation of supporting steel work
- concrete works
- installation of boom gate system
- power and comms connections.

The boom gate will be activated when the new Prince of Wales Hospital Acute Services Building opens to patients.

Once operational, the boom gate will be open between 7am and 10pm to enable efficient access between the campus car park and new ED. The boom gate will be closed after hours to restrict through traffic.

For the duration of the installation works, access to Magill Street will be limited to residential vehicles and construction equipment, and the Magill Street/Hospital Road intersection will remain closed.
