

Community Notice Randwick Campus Redevelopment



Construction Update

There has been significant progress on the Randwick Campus Redevelopment site throughout 2024, with main works progressing on both the Sydney Children's Hospital Stage 1 and Minderoo Children's Comprehensive Cancer Centre (SCH1/MCCCC) and UNSW Health Translation Hub (HTH) project sites, alongside ongoing internal works within the Prince of Wales Hospital Acute Services Building (ASB), and planning for refurbishment works in previously vacated spaces.

Upcoming activities

Sydney Children's Hospital Stage 1 and Minderoo Children's Comprehensive Cancer Centre

Internal fit-out and service installations continue across all floors within the new building.

Structural works on the future hospital entrance forecourt, located at the intersection of Hospital Road and High Street, will also continue throughout December and January. These works may result in some noise and pedestrian diversions.

Site sheds will continue to be removed during December. All works will take place within the construction site and during approved hours.

Holiday period site closures

Following a busy year of construction, our project sites will close for the holiday period:

SCH1/MCCCC – closed from 6pm on Friday 20 December 2024, reopening from 7am on Monday 6 January 2025.

UNSW HTH – closed from 6pm on Friday 20 December 2024, reopening from 7am on Monday 6 January 2025.

Internal fit-out works within the **Prince of Wales Hospital Acute Services Building and broader campus** will also pause from 6pm on
Friday 20 December 2024, recommencing from
7am on Monday 6 January 2025.

UNSW Health Translation Hub

Main works on the 15-storey building continues to progress, with the structure now at full height, marking a significant project milestone.

The installation of façade panels has been completed to Level 11 of the main tower, and internal fit-out and services installation is ongoing across all levels.

External forecourt works are set to commence in January, following completion of the façade.

Landscaping works adjacent to the new link bridge support column on Botany Street have been rescheduled for early 2025. These works will require a temporary closure of the western footpath and pedestrian diversions to the eastern footpath.

Prince of Wales Hospital Acute Services Building and broader campus

Internal fit-out works to deliver new operating theatres and associated spaces on Level 1 of the ASB will continue throughout December and January.

Refurbishment work in vacated areas across the hospital campus will begin in December and continue throughout 2025. Mitigation measures will be in place to minimise the impact of any associated construction noise on adjoining hospital areas.

Managing construction activities

We are committed to minimising the impact of our works. All construction activities are carried out with the health and safety of the local community and site workers as our top priority, and we endeavour to keep noise, dust and vibration to a minimum.

Where possible, activities are scheduled during approved site hours of **Monday to Friday**, **7am to 6pm and Saturday**, **8am to 5pm**. Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances.

Out of hours work will be communicated directly to affected stakeholders, and all activity dates and times remain subject to change. Inaudible concrete finishing and other works may extend beyond 6pm where necessary, in line with planning conditions. Delivery of construction materials and equipment may also be undertaken out of hours where required by law due to vehicle size.

Please note that service upgrades unrelated to the project may also be undertaken by other agencies at any time without notification.
