NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY

To support the Prince of Wales Hospital refurbishment works program being delivered as part of the Randwick Campus Redevelopment project, demolition construction activities will soon commence in vacated areas across the Randwick Hospitals' Campus. Temporary construction zones have been established to facilitate these works.

The vacated areas include:

- Level 3, Building 13, Randwick Hospitals Campus Centre (future Central Equipment Store)
- Level 0, Building 15, Dickinson Building (future Haemodialysis / Nephrology Outpatient Unit)
- Level 0, Building 15A, Former PECC (future Security Services and PoWH on-call rooms)

Demolition works will take place between 7am and 5pm weekdays from Wednesday 4 to Wednesday 18 December 2024. During this period, barricades and hoarding will be established around the temporary construction zones.

The work will include demolishing partitions, doors, flooring, ceilings and joinery which will result in localised noise and dust impacts within the construction zone. Mitigation measures will be in place to minimise noise as much as possible, including sealed perimeter walls and sticky mats.

A site manager will be present throughout the works to address any urgent issues. Contact details will be provided on the hoardings and barricades surrounding the construction zones.

Should you have any concerns or unexpected impacts to report, please direct them to your line manager in the first instance.
