

Test landing for new helipad – Thursday 12 January from 7pm to 9pm

The Prince of Wales Hospital (POWH) Acute Services Building (ASB) includes a new rooftop Helicopter Landing Site (HLS).

To finalise construction activity for the new HLS, a flight test will be carried out on **Thursday 12 January from 7pm to 9pm**, weather permitting.

During the test, a helicopter will arrive and depart from a variety of directions based on both wind conditions and air traffic clearances issued by tower control at Sydney Airport. Some noise can be expected during the test landing and take-off.

While testing is required to validate the new HLS, it will not be operational until the new Sydney Children's Hospital Stage 1 and Minderoo Children's Comprehensive Cancer Centre and Health Translation Hub projects near completion in 2025.

An additional flight test will be required towards the completion of those projects to operationally commission the HLS for emergency and patient transport services, with the existing campus helipad remaining operational until this time.
